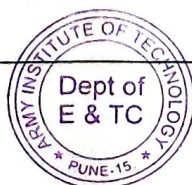

Agenda 1: Review of Academic Activities and Results <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Dr. G R Patil briefed about the various academic activities conducted in the department such as workshops, seminars, industrial visits and guest lectures.➤ Results of the year 2022-23 were good with T.E results around 89% and B.E results of 98%. S.E results were slightly lower than T.E.	Info: Committee
2.	Agenda 2: Discussion on Placement and Internship <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Dr. G. R. Patil remarked that the placements of the lastt year are quite good, with the highest salary being 24 Lakhs and average salary around 12.7 Lakhs➤ 115 students have got internships, with the highest package of Rs. 1,25,000/- pm offered by Deutsche Bank. 3.	Agenda 3: Discussion & Suggestions on NEP-2020 <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Dr. G.R. Patil spoke about NEP 2020 and discussed the main features of the policy	

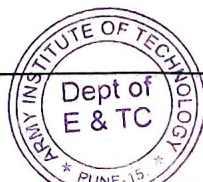




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	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ He told there is more emphasis on multidisciplinary/interdisciplinary courses, research and formative assessment.➤ Dr. G.R. Patil said that NEP 2020 would require many multidisciplinary courses and students would have academic Bank of Credits.➤ Special training may be needed for faculty.➤ Dr. Y. Ravinder remarked that faculty must be trained for multidisciplinary courses and tie-ups with industry will be essential.➤ Dr. Y. Ravinder also said that there would be an FDP on NEP from 15th-30th December 2023 and also in first week of January organized by the Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission which could be attended by the faculty.➤ Dr. Y. Ravinder said that courses under NPTEL and similar MOOCS could be given credits and could be discussed with the University for Affiliated Colleges.➤ Dr. Y. Ravinder also said that faculty in their college would be undergoing training under NITTTR, and IICEE, and on pedagogical skills. He also said that 2 credits are given for extracurricular activities in their college in proposed autonomy syllabus.➤ Mr. Baikunthnath Dwivedi remarked that as the industry looks for practical skills, courses should be introduced with hands-on product development.➤ Mr. Baikunthnath Dwivedi also said that Control systems and Automation field is expanding and students should be exposed to sensor-based control systems and different design toolboxes. He also said that students should know what is required for design of electronic systems.➤ Dr.B.P.Patil said that AIT is planning for autonomy from 2025-26 and requested cooperation and guidance from Dr. Y.Ravinder and PICT➤ Dr.B.P.Patil also said that placement process may need to be modified, as industry would not be aware of NEP	Action : Facult y and studen ts
4.	<p><u>Agenda 4: Revision of Program Educational Objectives (PEOs)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Dr. G R Patil said that the NBA committee had remarked that PEOs need to be revised as current PEOs are not reflecting graduate professional accomplishments.➤ Dr. G R Patil also said that due to revision in syllabus and NEP implementation, PEOS are required to be changed.➤ He told feedback from stakeholders will be taken.➤ Sample PEOS of different colleges like BMS College Banglore, NIT Warangal, COEP etc. have been studied and PEO statements are under revision. 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5.	<p>Discussion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Dr.G.R.Patil invited panel members and students for any queries.➤ Dr. P.B.Karandikar asked Dr. Ravinder for suggestions to improve projects from students➤ Dr. Ravinder remarked that PICT had made it compulsory for students to write research papers in the first semester of final year. The second semester would focus on the development stage, and this would automatically improve project quality.➤ Dr. Ravinder also said that some topics were given by faculty to students and this would be helpful as the faculty could guide students more effectively.➤ Dr. shraddha Oza asked Dr. Ravinder whether Innovation and entrepreneurship (I&E) was included in autonomy syllabus as credits, to which Dr. /Ravinder replied that 2 credits were given for 30 hours of work in one semester for co-curricular activities, including I&E.➤ Mr. Kaviarasan said that there should be more focus on research and papers.➤ Dr. G.R. Patil remarked that this would be possible if more students approached faculty to work on projects.
