Rajesh is an alumnus of AIT, Pune - 2002 Computer Science batch. He was a gold medalist in academics and the best outgoing student of his batch. His "15 seconds of fame" moment in college was when he represented India at the Imagine Cup World Finals in Seoul in 2001 and was personally felicitated by Bill Gates.
