OBSERVATIONS:

This notice aims to address the need for focused efforts to improve the academic performance of our final-year students. After analysing the result of AY 2023-24 following points were observed by the IQAC:

Upon reviewing the results for the AY 2023-24, it is observed that students scored below the expected benchmarks. Upon analysing the recent results, we have noticed a trend in certain subjects where performance is not meeting expectations. There has been a significant dip in scores:

- 1. In SE E&TC, many students scoring below Distinction [33.94%].
- 2. In SE COMP, 13% students passed with ATKT.
- 3. In SE IT, many students scoring below Distinction [21%] and 13% students passed with ATKT with 11% failures.
- 4. In SE MECH, a notable count of students scored below Distinction [55%] and 28% students passed with ATKT with 2% failures.
- 5. In TE MECH, many students scoring below Distinction [40.81%].
- 6. BE MECH, 37% students scored below Distinction.
- 7. In ASGE,20.19% students passed with ATKT.



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DATA REQURIED:

1. Provide the subject wise list of students progressed to higher class with ATKT.

- 2. Remedial action taken for current ATKT students.
- 3. Action taken by Department to improve result next year
- 4. Action plan to achieve 100% pass percentage Result.

RECOMMENDED ACTION TAKEN: As we approach the conclusion of the academic year, it has become evident that a significant improvement in our students' results is essential for their academic growth and future opportunities. We request all concerned faculty members to take the following actions to support the students in their academic endeavours:

- 1. Conduct Remedial Classes: Please arrange for additional sessions or one-on-one tutorials to address gaps in knowledge.
- 2. **Provide Timely Feedback:** Ensure that students receive prompt and constructive feedback on assignments and exams to help them improve.
- 3. **Motivational Sessions:** We recommend organizing motivational or guidance sessions to encourage students and help them develop a positive mindset towards their studies.
- 4. **Assessments and Mock Tests:** Conduct more frequent assessments or mock tests, especially in subjects that have shown poor performance trends.
- 5. **Personalized Attention:** Identify students who may need extra help and provide them with the necessary resources or study materials.
