



Kaagaz is a made in India document scanning app launched in June 2020, and today that it has 10 Million+Downloads and has been accepted into the accelerator program by Y Combinator (W'22). With over 2.5 Mn+ monthly active users, Kaagaz today has evolved to be a top productivity & office tool on Google Play Store.
