The University at Buffalo reserves the right to rescind admission and revoke the I-20 Certificate of Visa Eligibility if it learns that any fraudulent documents were submitted, if any false or misleading statements were submitted, or if any required information or documents were omitted as part of your application.

We are enthusiastic about you joining our MS in MIS program. You will begin your MS MIS journey with the MS Advantage program. Your academic advisor will email you in June with specific orientation dates and details. International MS students must also attend the University's International Student Orientation. Please plan to arrive in Buffalo mid-August. Classes begin on **August 29, 2022**.

If you choose to accept your spot in the UB MS in MIS program please submit your non-refundable \$500 tuition deposit by **February 15, 2022**. Deposits must be paid via credit card. Your UB person number is required to pay this deposit. If you have already uploaded all I-20 materials, you will receive an email with instructions to access your UB person number, along with the tuition deposit link, within 2-3 weeks. If you have not uploaded your I-20 materials, please upload them to your application immediately. I-20 issuance can take up to 6 weeks. Please note that we reserve the right to refuse tuition deposits received after the deadline.

In accordance with New York State Public Health Law, UB requires that all students (undergraduate, graduate, professional) born on or after January 1, 1957 provide proof of immunity against measles, mumps and rubella. The state also requires that all students receive information about meningococcal disease and have made an informed decision about whether or not to receive immunization against meningococcal disease. UB students will not be allowed to register for classes until they have fulfilled these requirements.
