AIT adopts Khamgaon village in Junnar taluka

CITY-BASED Army Institute of Technology (AIT) has adopted Khamgaon village in Junnar taluka of Pune district.

The AIT has also launched various initiatives to create awareness about social issues under the National Service Scheme (NSS).

A press release from the institute said a week-long camp was held from January 16 to 21.




