Institute organizes sessions on Gender Sensitization during the Induction Program. Women's Day Celebration in college also includes a session on Gender. HEI comments for the metric:

1. Peer Team was fully satisfied in this metric and no adverse, negative points were given by them. Institute actively involves its faculty members in curriculum development through participation in Board of Studies (BoS) meetings and curriculum review and implementation workshops by SPPU.
2. The institute and its departments plan academic calendars in accordance with SPPU's schedule, focusing on student development and learning outcomes. Faculty members complete training and certifications for new courses, align teaching plans with outcomes, share materials via MS Teams/Moodle, and rigorously implement CIA through assignments, tests, seminars, and tutorials, with progress continuously monitored in IQAC meetings.
3. AICTE/SPPU guided structured induction program and supports 25+ student clubs ensure boosted skills and enhance employability. Ensuring continuous improvement and accountability exercised through regular academic audits.
4. During discussion peer team repeatedly mentioned AIT as premier institute but marks awarded does not reflect the same.
