4.1.1 The Institution has adequate infrastructure and other facilities for, teaching – learning, viz., classrooms, laboratories, computing equipment etc ICT – enabled facilities such as smart class, LMS etc. Facilities for Cultural and sports activities, yoga centre, games (indoor and outdoor), Gymnasium, auditorium etc	All relevant documents, including detailed layouts, utilization reports, and photographic evidence, were uploaded in the SSR. These documents clearly demonstrate the adequacy, accessibility, and optimal use of our infrastructure.  In response to the observations made during the NAAC 2022 Accreditation cycle, AIT has undertaken proactive and targeted measures to address the suggested improvements.  Barrier-free access has been ensured in buildings previously lacking such provisions, and common rooms for both boys and girls already available in hostels are now being established within academic buildings.  Furthermore, existing facilities have been renovated, and additional state-of-the-art laboratories and classrooms have been developed, along with supplementary amenities, to promote inclusivity and enhance overall student welfare.	Library, BMS/UPS Room, Reading Hall and Conference Room). Library is with "SLIM21 system for library information and management" software that manages and integrates multiple core library functions and services. The Institute also has state of art mini data center with

## **HEI** comments for the metric:

- 1. Infrastructure & Facilities: The 30-acre campus includes a 51,317 m<sup>2</sup> built-up area with 20 ICT-enabled classrooms (5 smart classrooms), 2 seminar halls, 2 conference halls, 9 tutorial rooms, 46 labs, a workshop, and 3 sponsored labs. It also houses a Centre of Excellence in AI and Robotics and a workshop with advanced tools like five X 3D printers, HPC Server, smart TVs and CNC machines.
- **2. Connectivity & Digital Systems**: The campus has 2048 Mbps (2 Gbps) internet via Class-A ISPs, 120 access points for 2000+ users, and an educational ERP system for managing admissions, faculty, and student interactions.
- **3. Student Support & Inclusivity**: The institute offers 8 cultural venues, 17 sports facilities, and 14+ student clubs with allocated space. It ensures accessibility with ramps, special toilets, a passenger lift, and 775 CCTV cameras for campus-wide surveillance.
- **4. Renovations (AY 2021-22 to 24-25):** Classrooms: **04**, Labs: **14**, Washrooms: **08** Ladies + **08** Gents, Sports: **02** Volleyball courts + **01** Kabaddi ground 5. Even after so much improvement and renovation the current score is reduced by 1 which demoralises the institute.
