HEI comments for the metric:

1. AIT has demonstrated consistent success through a steady rise in high CTC placements, strong internship-to-placement conversion rates, and active participation in skill benchmarking platforms like AMCAT. Despite challenges such as limited industry access, the institution has effectively addressed them through strategic partnerships and alumni engagement.
2. AIT has facilitated 456 project-based internships and attracted over 90 companies offering “dream” and “super-dream” job opportunities. The institution also hosted 18 expert lectures, 40+ workshops, incubated 8 startups, and earned national recognition through prestigious scholarships from Google, Reliance Foundation, and Deutsche Bank.
3. AIT affirms that its well-documented and sustained practices align with NAAC’s focus on quality enhancement and innovation, producing measurable, transformational outcomes for students and the academic community, supported by verified and uploaded documentary evidence
4. No adverse comments were received. In spite of appreciation from peer team 50% score is awarded which is unjust. We expect a score of 4.
