## CONDUCT OF 8<sup>TH</sup> SEMESTER EXAMS FOR BE STUDENTS

- 1. Number of inputs and posts are coming up in the social media with regard to conduct of end semester exams by SPPU in July 2020. Times of India Pune Edition has also come out with certain announcements made by the Pro Vice Chancellor. In succeeding paragraphs, an attempt is being made to clarify the important aspects as it is known till now.
- 2. SPPU has not formally declared the exact schedule of exams. However, certain proposals have been discussed during a recent Academic Council Meet of SPPU, which need to be approved by higher authorities. Some of these points have been published on the social media platforms also. As per the above proposals, Final Semester Exams for BE students are being planned during 01 to 31 Jul 2020, which also include backlogs of BE students in 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> semesters. The backlog exams will be held between 01 to 15 Jul and regular BE theory exams will be held between 16 to 31 Jul. However final decision and all the relevant details will be conveyed officially though a circular by SPPU by end of this month.
- 3. In order to give adequate time to the students to follow all laid down protocols before appearing for exams, it has been decided that all BE students having backlogs will report to AIT hostels between 14 and 17 June 2020. Regular students without backlogs should report after 27 Jun, but not later than 02 Jul 2020.
- 4. It will be mandatory for <u>all students</u> to stay inside AIT Hostels and be quarantined for the period of 14 days before exams and during the period of exams. All day scholars and those who have been staying outside AIT will report to AIT hostels as per above dates and continue to stay till their exams are completed. This is to ensure safety of students and also to avoid hassles at each individual colony / society for entry / exit, where the students have been staying earlier. Such students will be charged only for messing and actual expenditures.

- 5. Any student who was not a regular student during Second Semester of Academic Year 2019-20, and has wishes to appear for these exams (earlier batch backlog) will separately inform through email to jd@aitpune.edu.in., giving details of period during which he / she is requesting to stay inside AIT hostels. Such students, who do not take prior approval, will not be accommodated in AIT hostels.
- 6. Mr. Ravi Kumar, of M/s Udchalo is being contacted for assisting students in providing flight bookings to BE students who are desirous of arriving by flight to Pune. Such students have to provide details to include name, starting station and proposed date of travel by 05 Jun 2020 on email to officesuptdt@aitpune.edu.in.
- 7. All students arriving at AIT hence forth will have Arogya Setu App installed in their respective mobiles. They will wear facemasks, carry a bottle of sanitizer and follow social distancing guidelines strictly during journey. They will report to AIT Main Gate for body temperature check and other laid down protocols.
- 8. All students who report to AIT will henceforth be in possession of their Dependent Card or ECHS Card.
- 9. Further administrative and/or academic instructions will be issued after issue of formal notice by SPPU.
