3) Extensions - Stuff that mya need to extend your product (hooks that you leave for the future)
6. Don't over-engineer or overs standardize in the first few builds - follow the Japanese 3S - first, set to order (just make it work); then, shine (make it better); last, standardize (make it scalable and pluggable)
7. Make yourself familiar with the legalities of your product domain (eg, RoHS certification for wireless products, data privacy laws for data-based products, healthcare legalities for health-based products, etc)
8. Assess the scale of your product usage ta 1-year mark (don't worry abt being wrong - its a guesstimate)
9. There is no need to go for the latest-&-greatest technologies - start with the simplest stuff that gets you to MVP fastest. "Simple & stable" is better than "latest & greatest"

I'm done, but it's a sin to leave anything at (9) :o) ... so here's the (10):

10. You cannot not be an expert in everything. Yes, even if you are an engineer. Ask for help & advice from people in related domains, where you need to know the details.
